FIXED TERM POSITIONS TERMS 2 AND 3 2018

We are currently seeking dynamic and passionate educators who can replace staff members on Leave and contribute fully to learning at the College.

POSITIONS

- These are fixed-term positions replacing staff on Leave.
 - There are a range of classes in these positions.
 - It may be possible to combine aspects of some roles to suit particular applicants' skills and experience.
 - You will be expected to contribute enthusiastically to the College's co-curricular program.
 - You will be expected to contribute to the College's pastoral care programme.
 - You will be supported by a Mentor appointed to assist you during your term.
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- One of the positions needing replacement is 0.8fte and involves providing students at the Primary School and in the Middle Years Centre (Years 6-8) with literacy and numeracy assistance on a one-to-one or small group basis. This position exists from Monday 16 April to Friday 22 June (inclusive).
 - One of the positions needing replacement is 0.8fte and involves the teaching of Mathematics and Outdoor Education at Year 8 level and also teaching Physical Education in Junior and Senior Schools. This position exists from Monday 16 July to Friday 21 September (inclusive).
 - One of the positions needing replacement is full-time and requires a primary-trained educator who can teach a range of subjects at Year 6 level and some Digital Technology to a Year 7 class. This position exists from Monday 21 May to Friday 21 September (inclusive).

- Able and willing to use technology competently in your teaching.
- Keen to inspire a love of learning in your students.
