The Hamilton and Alexandra College promotes opportunities for boys and girls of excellent character and the sons and daughters, grandsons and granddaughters of Old Collegians to make a significant contribution to the life of the College and beyond as future citizens.

General Excellence for all-round achievement provides a wonderful opportunity for boys and girls to benefit from membership of the The Hamilton and Alexandra College community.

In assessing each application, weight is given to the range of a student's achievements, with particular reference

- Strong academic merit: boys and girls applying will have good reports from their school. EduTest results will be considered, if available.
- Character and leadership attributes: boys and girls must demonstrate ability to lead and a ready willingness to participate in a variety of educational and College related activities.
- Strength in co-curricular and citizenship activities: boys and girls will demonstrate their participation, service and achievement in one or more of the following College activities; sport, drama, music, visual or performing arts, service learning and outdoor pursuits.

Subject to meeting the necessary annual criteria, the scholarship will be tenable until the student has completed their secondary education and will be awarded on the basis of current school reports, references, application information and an interview with the Principal and his delegates. A formal review in July and December of each year is conducted to ensure all our Scholarship holders maximize their opportunity.

The recipients of the awards will receive a maximum reduction of 50% in Tuition Fees. This is discussed at the meeting with the Principal. Successful boarding applicants may receive a discount in Tuition and Boarding Fees.

Administrative charges and other fees will still be payable. A copy of the current fee schedule is included for your information.

Applicants for General Excellence Scholarships should arrange for the following to be submitted:-

- 1. The Scholarship Application Form the "Personal Particulars" section is to be completed by the applicants themselves.
- 2. A copy of the most recent school report from the applicant's current school.
- 3. NAPLAN results.
- 4. List 2 personal referee contact details including phone numbers.
- 5. A current passport photo of the applicant.
