

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Hamilton and Alexandra College is proud to award scholarships to boys and girls of exceptional academic potential who will make a significant contribution to the life of the College and beyond as future citizens.

Academic Scholarships are awarded on the basis of demonstrated performance in the examination administered by Edutest and supporting documentation e.g. school reports, external competition reports, NAPLAN results, together with any other qualities that will allow a child to contribute positively to the life of the College.

All boys and girls who are short listed for an Academic Scholarship will be invited for an interview to explore their own academic interests, their approach to learning and how they will contribute to the strong learning culture at College.

Examinations to enter Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 will be held on Saturday 15th February 2020.

Day Students will receive a minimum of 25% reduction in Tuition Fees. Boarding Students will receive a minimum of 25% reduction of Tuition Fees and a minimum of 25% reduction in Boarding Fees.

Subject to meeting the necessary annual criteria, the scholarship will be tenable until the student has completed their secondary education and will be awarded on the basis of current school reports, references, application information and an interview with the Principal and the Associate Principal, Operations. A formal review in July and December of each year is conducted to ensure all our Scholarship holders maximize their opportunity.

Administrative charges and other fees will still be payable. A copy of the current fee schedule is included for your information.

The Scholarship papers are set and marked by EduTest. Results will not become available until March and all candidates and their parents will be notified of their results.

Applicants for Academic Scholarships should arrange to bring the following if invited for an interview:-

- 1. A copy of the applicant's most recent school reports
- 2. NAPLAN results
- 3. External competition reports
- 4. A current passport photo of the applicant
