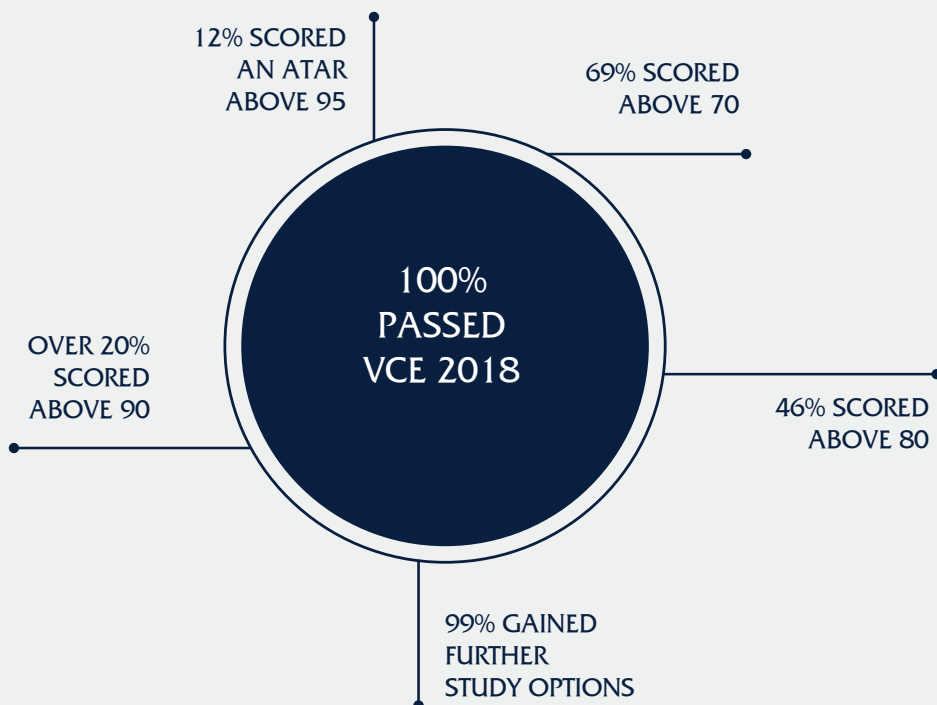

The Hamilton and Alexandra College's VCE results have again placed the College amongst the top regional schools in Australia.

Every College student passed their VCE and our 2018 Year 12 cohort achieved the best top end results since 2012, with eight students joining the College scholar list with an ATAR over 95.

Over 20% of the College's VCE students scored above 90, 46% scored above 80 and over two-thirds of the cohort scored above 70, enabling each of these students a plethora of post

school tertiary options.

The Hamilton and Alexandra College offers boys and girls a vast range of subjects across different disciplines to allow each student to discover their own study path, suited to their own strengths and interests.

The College attributes its focus on student wellbeing, expert teaching, high expectations and academic assistance as central to its academic achievement.
