

#### **IVY SCHOLARSHIPS**

At The Hamilton and Alexandra College we pride ourselves on attracting the best and brightest students to our College. Our core business is education, so pursuit of excellence underpins our pedagogy. The Hamilton and Alexandra College promotes opportunities for boys and girls of excellent character and the sons and daughters, grandsons and granddaughters of Old Collegians to make a significant contribution to the life of the College and beyond as future citizens.

Ivy Scholarships are awarded for meritorious achievement and provide a wonderful opportunity for boys and girls to benefit from membership of The Hamilton and Alexandra College community.

In assessing each application, weight is given to the range of a student's achievements, with particular reference to:

- Strong academic merit: boys and girls applying will have good reports from their school. **EduTest** results will be considered.
- Character and leadership attributes: boys and girls must demonstrate an interest to lead and a ready willingness to serve their local communities.
- Strength in co-curricular activities: boys and girls must demonstrate their participation and achievement in one or more of the following College activities; sport, drama, music, visual or performing arts and outdoor pursuits.

Ivy Scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit. Current school reports, references and application information will be assessed and an interview will be held with the Principal and his delegates. A formal review in July and December of each year is conducted to ensure all our Scholarship holders maximize their opportunity. The College will award ten Ivy Scholarships to each year group. Subject to meeting the necessary annual criteria, the scholarship will be tenable until the student has completed their secondary education.

The recipients of Ivy Scholarships will receive a maximum reduction of 25% in Tuition Fees. This is discussed at the meeting with the Principal. Successful boarding applicants may receive a discount in Tuition and Boarding Fees.

Administrative charges and other fees will still be payable. A copy of the current fee schedule is included for your information.

Applicants for General Excellence Scholarships should arrange for the following to be submitted:-

- 1. The Scholarship Application Form the "Personal Particulars" section is to be completed by the applicants themselves.
- 2. A copy of the most recent school report from the applicant's current school.
- 3. A copy of the most recent NAPLAN results.
- 4. List 2 personal referee contact details including phone numbers.
- 5. A current passport photo of the applicant.
- 6. Must sit the Edutest testing.
