## DAY BOARDING PROGRAM

Your child can participate in the after-school activities they love, eat dinner and finish their homework - all before they get home. They can also access a member of the academic staff after dinner in the Boarding House. . You can have peace of mind knowing your child is being cared for in a safe, supportive and familiar environment.

## WHO USES DAY BOARDING?

This is a great option for all Senior School families. It may be convenient for busy parents or if you live a distance from school and the student has a late training or returning after the school bus from an excursion. Many families utilise this option during sporting seasons and production rehearsals, for example, as it saves time when families have multiple children doing after school activities or parents themselves have after work commitments.

## STRUCTURE

### After school

3.30pm Walk to Boarding House (where afternoon tea is provided) or after-school activity (can arrange a pick up) or tutoring/study session in Senior School library

*NB: Students are not permitted to go into town*

5.50 pm Assemble in the Refectory for dinner  
6.00 pm Dinner  
7.00 pm Study begins for all year levels  
8.30 pm Pick up for Years 7-9 (end of study)  
9.00 pm Pick up time for Years 10 to 12 (end of study)

## YOU WILL NEED

- School books for study
- A mobile phone with credit (so you can contact home if required)

## PROGRAM

More and more families are using this service for one, two or three evenings (Monday to Thursday) each week, depending on the needs of your family.

## EXPECTATIONS

Day boarders are required to be aware and follow all School and Boarding House rules. Students and their parents must also be aware of these rules and Boarding House expectations.

## COST

Day Boarding is \$60.00 per day (charged to your school account).
