The Hamilton and Alexandra College promotes opportunities for students of excellent character and the children and grandchildren of Old Collegians to make a significant contribution to the life of the College and beyond as confident citizens.

Academic Scholarships are awarded on the demonstrated performance in the examination administered by Edutest and supporting documentation e.g. school reports, external competition reports, NAPLAN results.

All students who are short listed for an Academic Scholarship will be invited for an interview to discuss and explore their academic interests, their approach to learning and how they will contribute to the strong learning culture at College.

## Examinations to enter Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 will be held on Saturday 24 February 2024.

- Day students will receive a minimum of 25% reduction in Tuition Fees.
- Boarding students will receive a minimum of 25% reduction of Tuition Fees and a minimum of 25% reduction in Boarding Fees.

Subject to meeting the necessary annual criteria, the scholarship will be tenable until the student has completed their secondary education and will be awarded on the basis of current school reports, references, application information and an interview with the Principal and their delegates. A formal review in July and December of each year is conducted to ensure all our Academic Scholarship holders are maximizing their opportunities at The Hamilton and Alexandra College.

Administrative charges and other fees will still be payable. A copy of the current fee schedule is included for your information.

The Academic Scholarship papers are set and marked by EduTest. Results will not become available until March and all candidates and their parents will be notified of their results.

#### Applicants for Academic Scholarships should arrange to bring the following if invited for an interview:-

- 1. A copy of the applicant's most recent school reports
- 2. NAPLAN results
- 3. External competition reports
- 4. A current passport photo of the applicant
