



The Hamilton and Alexandra College promotes opportunities for students of excellent character to make a significant contribution to the life of the College and beyond as confident citizens.

For all Tower Scholarships, families will be required to demonstrate that their present and likely future financial circumstances would not allow them to finance their children's attendance at The Hamilton and Alexandra College. Families will be asked to complete a confidential financial questionnaire. This would include copies of recent taxation returns, statement of assets and liabilities and a Statutory Declaration attesting to their financial position and indicating their interests in Trusts, Companies and Partnerships. This can be obtained from the Business Manager.

In assessing each application, weight is given to the range of a student's achievements, with particular reference to:

- **Strong academic:** students applying will have good reports and references from their school. **EduTest** results will be considered, if available.
- **Character and leadership attributes:** students must demonstrate Ability to lead and a ready willingness to participate in a variety of educational and College related activities.
- **Strength in co-curricular and citizenship activities:** students will demonstrate their participation, service and achievement in one or more of the following College activities; sport, drama, music, visual or performing arts, service learning and outdoor pursuits.
- **Confidential financial questionnaire**

The Tower Scholarship will be tenable until the student has completed their secondary education.

A family's financial status would need to be confirmed annually to ensure that the Tower Scholarship continues to be awarded on the basis of financial need.

The recipients of the Tower Scholarship will receive a significant reduction in fees. This is discussed at the meeting with the Principal.

Administrative charges and other fees will still be payable. A copy of the current fee schedule is included for your information.

Applicants for a Bursary should arrange for the following to be submitted:-

1. **The Tower Scholarship Application Form – the "Personal Particulars" section is to be completed by the applicants themselves.**
2. **A copy of the applicant's most recent school report.**
3. **List two personal referee contact details including phone numbers**
4. **Recent NAPLAN results**
5. **A current passport photo of the applicant**
6. **Confidential financial questionnaire**
